16.103 Superfast Broadband: update: Cllr Parish

UK Power Networks has connected the new cabinet to mains electricity. However, the Superfast Essex web site is not showing the cabinet to be 'live'.

Gigaclear, a private company which brings fibre to each house, is currently canvassing in the village. This company requires 30% of households to sign up to the scheme to enable the village to benefit from the service.

Gigaclear hosted a public presentation in Duddenhoe End and are partnered by Superfast Essex.

16.104 Proposed meeting day change: amendment to Standing Orders by resolution

PROPOSED: Cllr Jackson, seconded Cllr Slade. AGREED AND RESOLVED UNANIMOUSLY.
