 The Village Hall Committee has raised a further £15,000 in grant funding from the Thomas Amos Charity, and a vote of thanks was offered to the Village Hall Committee, particularly Guy Rackham and Mike Dearman, and the Charity.

Suitable storage is required, and application was made to the Parish Council for a storage building to be sited on an unobtrusive area of the burial ground. Jane Holloway expressed concern that the proposed storage building and fencing may be installed without a commitment by pre-school that they would be moving to the site.

PROPOSAL: That Chrishall Parish Council agrees in principle that Chrishall Village Hall Committee has permission to install a suitable storage facility for use by the Committee on the burial ground, subject to the site being *agreed.* PROPOSED: John Kay, seconded Jane Holloway. AGREED AND RESOLVED UNANIMOUSLY

Derek Ailes proposed that further funding be provided by the Parish Council to ensure that all works can be finished in a timely manner.

PROPOSAL: That Chrishall Parish Council agree, subject to grant funding application achievement by Chrishall Village Hall Committee, that £2,500 (two thousand five hundred pounds) will be allocated to Chrishall Village Hall Committee to ensure all necessary works are funded, if this is necessary.

- 15.37 Electronic Payment: policy & procedure Following discussion, Councillors did not believe that the amount of expenditure incurred by the Parish Council warranted electronic payment. No action is to be taken.
- 15.38 Chrishall School Hall & Village Hall: update Pre-school request to hire for Easter Egg hunt including burial ground Following extensive discussion and expression of significant concerns, Councillors agreed that the burial ground was not a suitable venue for an Easter Egg hunt. The Clerk will advise the Village Hall Committee.

Derek Ailes reported that the School is keen to take on the old village hall as soon as possible. A School Governor has commented that Essex County Council will not consider funding the building until a formal date for commencement of the licence to occupy has been agreed. Councillors agreed this would be the 1st September 2015. It was further agreed that, in the spirit of good will, the school would be able to use the building as soon as it was vacated by pre-school, free of charge, to enable necessary alterations to be done to provide the facilities the school required.

PROPOSAL: That Chrishall Parish Council agrees that Chrishall Primary School will have free use of Chrishall Old Village Hall once it is vacant and prior to the commencement of the autumn 2015 term, to enable necessary adaptation of the building for commencement of the formal Licence to Occupy commencing 1st September 2015. PROPOSED Derek Ailes, seconded John Kay. AGREED AND RESOLVED UNANIMOUSLY

Hastoe has confirmed that it has secured funding for the erection of the affordable units. Hastoe has also confirmed that it will manage the removal of the newts subject to the transfer of the newt licence from the land owner. However, Hastoe is seeking financial contributions towards the ecology from the landowner.
